

Superintendent & CEO, New Horizons Charter School

Position: Applications are invited for the position of Superintendent & CEO New Horizons Charter School located in Sherwood Park, Alberta. Duties to commence July 1, 2023 or as mutually agreed.

Role: The Board is required to appoint a Superintendent in accordance with Section 222 and 224 of the Education Act and the Superintendent of Schools Regulation. The Superintendent shall perform the duties articulated in legislation and in Board policy as amended from time to time.

Candidate: The ideal candidate will possess successful, broad-based leadership experience as a central office and school-based administrator, preferably at the CEO level. In addition, the candidate must, at minimum, hold a Master's degree, hold or qualify for Alberta teaching certification, Alberta Leadership certification and superintendent leadership certification and have a passion for the charter school option and gifted education.

New Horizons School is a rapidly growing K-9 public charter school that enables academically gifted students to achieve excellence in an environment that supports the students' unique intellectual, social and emotional needs. Established in 1995, New Horizons is Alberta's oldest charter school. As a publicly funded charter school in Alberta, New Horizons charges no tuition fees and follows the Alberta programs of study. New Horizons School is unique in that it offers a congregated learning environment for over 425 gifted learners for the entire school day. It is a place where gifted learners can be challenged and learn with like minded peers. The School is located in Sherwood Park, Alberta (population over 70,000) and serves the needs of gifted learners from Strathcona County and other communities across the Capital Region, including Edmonton. The operating budget for 2022-2023 is \$4.9 million. The school employs a staff of approximately 30, comprised of teachers and support staff members: various services are also provided by several contract service providers. School Profile

General

- Rapidly growing enrollment. The school now has two classrooms per grade and has reached capacity. Enrollment is currently 427 in grades K-9.
- ➤ The school is located at 1000 Strathcona Drive in Sherwood Park AB population 70,000 and serves the needs of gifted learners from Strathcona County and other communities across the capital region, including the city of Edmonton.

Governance

- New Horizons Charter School Society is the legal entity that operates the school. The Society has entered into an agreement (ie charter) with Alberta's Minister of Education that enables the school to operate and that establishes the conditions of its operation.
- ➤ The Board of Directors is elected by members of the New Horizons Charter School Society and provides overall governance to the school. The Board consists of up to seven directors, elected for a two-year term. Terms are staggered to provide for continuity on the Board.

Financial

- ➤ The Board provides the direction and approves the operating budget.
- > The Board is fiscally prudent.

Transportation

Student transportation is provided through a transportation agreement with Elk Island Public Schools.

Facilities

- ➤ A Board priority is to provide high school programing in alignment with the New Horizons School Charter.
- ➤ The school in 2019 completed an \$8 million (K-9) modernization at its current address.

Stability

➤ The school has been operating since 1995, longer than any other charter school in Alberta and was the first charter school in Canada.
